

List of items and substances prohibited for shipment in Russia

The list is formed on the basis of Art. 22 of the Federal Law "On Postal Communications." Accordingly, we cannot fulfill orders for delivery:

1. **Weapons of any type** - firearms (in the assembly and in separate parts) , signal, pneumatic, gas, cold, throwing;
2. **Ammunition;**
3. **Electroshock devices, spark gaps;**
4. **Harmful to health and dangerous substances** - narcotic, psychotropic, potent, radioactive, explosive, caustic, flammable and others;
5. **Poisonous animals and plants;**
6. **Money** - Russian and foreign currencies (coins, banknotes and their equivalents);
7. **Perishable foodstuffs, drinks;**
8. **Items**, nature or packaging of which may endanger postal and courier workers cause damage to other shipments and equipment for storing and transporting goods;
9. **Non-ferrous metals**, products from them;
10. **Precious and semi-precious stones**, products from them;
11. **Human remains;**
12. **Items of Artistic value** - paintings, icons, antiques.

For international destinations

There are several reasons for the formation of the list. These include the legislation of the Russian Federation, the Acts of the Universal Postal Union, the Rules for the provision of postal services. The List of items prohibited and conditionally admitted for import into foreign countries is also taken into account (source - Guidelines for accepting international mail). In accordance with the listed regulatory documents:

1. **Excise stamps** of excisable goods;
2. **Antiques, art collections, works of art** (paintings only with a certificate from the Ministry of Culture);
3. Official seals;
4. State awards;
5. **Bank cards;**
6. **Banknotes** - coins, banknotes, their equivalents;
7. **Valueable documents**
8. **Jewelry** - precious metals and stones, jewelry;
9. Books published before 1950;
10. **Natural furs, fur products (more than 5 units)**
11. **Identity cards** - passports of all types, military cards, birth certificates of minor children and other documents of this category;

12. **Printed materials** and other information carriers containing state secrets;
13. **Animals, plants;**
14. **Infectious and poisonous substances;**
15. **Cosmetic and hygiene products, perfumes;**
16. **Medicines** and their components;
17. **Products of plant and animal origin, biological materials;**
18. **Chemicals** and components;
19. **Cylinders with compressed or liquefied gas, aerosols;**
20. **Power sources** - batteries, accumulators;
21. Liquids;
22. Internal combustion engines;
23. **Magnetized materials** and items containing them;
24. **Weapons** of all types, ammunition, **explosives**, pyrotechnics - both in assembly and components;
25. **Items** whose transportation is **prohibited by laws in the countries of departure, destination, transit;**
26. **Cargo** requiring special export permits;
27. **Food, food additives;**
28. **Radioactive materials** and items containing them;
29. **Mercury barometers and thermometers;**
30. **Cigarettes** and other tobacco products;
31. **Matches, lighters** and filling cans for them;
32. **Dry ice, liquid nitrogen;**
33. **Dual-use goods;**
34. **Human remains;**
35. Pornographic materials;
36. Military radio components and other equipment components;
37. Stuffed toys (only with relevant certificates);
38. Welding helmet (only with relevant certificates).

Attention! The exceptions are individuals or legal entities that have permission from the relevant authorities to transport prohibited goods.
